BEARCATS HEAD TO ITHACA FOR MEETING WITH IVY PRESEASON FAVORITES CORNELL

Binghamton (1-4) will face a tough task as it looks to rebound from its third consecutive loss, when they visit Newman Arena for a matchup with preseason Ivy League favorites Cornell.

ON CORNELL

Cornell (3-1) returns three starters from a 2006-07 team that went 16-12 and finished third in the Ivy League. The Big Red are coming off a 83-77 win over preseason MAAC favorite Siena Sunday. Louis Dale scored 20 points and had nine rebounds to lead Cornell's 55 percent shooting effort. Sharp-shooting forward Ryan Wittman, the 2007 Ivy League Rookie of the Year, leads six Big Red players averaging double figures in scoring with 15.5 points per game. Cornell is averaging 88 points per game on a terrific 51.1 percent shooting from the field, and 50 (43-86) percent from beyond the arc. The Big Red are bolstered by the return of sophomore Adam Gore, the 2006 Ivy League rookie of the year. Gore started all 28 games for the Big Red and scored 12.9 points per game. He scored 20 points and hit five 3-pointers in his 2006-07 debut, only to suffer a season-ending knee injury in the final seconds of the game. Gore is averaging 10.3 points per game.

ON THE ALL-TIME SERIES

By virtue of last season's 57-56 victory at the Events Center, Binghamton recorded its first victory in four career meetings against the Big Red...In that game, Lazar Trifunovic sank two free throws with 27 seconds left and the Bearcats withstood two inside shots in the frantic waning seconds to preserve the victory. Trifunovic had 12 points, while Richard Forbes added 13 of his own...Last year's meeting was the first between the two Central New York schools in 16 years.

ON THE HORIZON: NEW JERSEY BOUND

The Bearcats play the final game of a three-game road stretch on Saturday when they face MAAC opponent Rider. The Broncs take a 3-3 record headed into Wednesday's home date with New Jersey Tech.

PREGAME NOTEBOOK

• Senior guard **Richard Forbes** is leading the Bearcats in scoring at a 16.6 point per game clip. Forbes is shooting 47.6% from the floor and a team-best 85.7% from the line (18-for-21). He has twice eclipsed the 20-point plateau this season, including a 25-point, 10-of-15 shooting performance against Central Connecticut State on November 20. Sophomore forward **Lazar Trifunovic** is averaging a double-double with 15.8 points and 10.6 rebounds per contest. Trifunovic is coming off a 17-point, 13-board performance at Akron. He has scored in double figures in four straight contests. Senior point guard **Mike Gordon** continues his solid play at the point for the Bearcats with 9.0 points, 5.0 assists, and 2.6 steals per game. Gordon enters Tuesday's contest having started 77 consecutive games at point spot for Binghamton.

AKRON POSTGAME WRAPUP

BU shot a season-low 30.6 (15-49) percent from the field and 20 (3-15) percent from three-point range and failed to record at least 10 assists for the first time this season (4)...Led by Lazar Trifunovic's 13 boards, BU outrebounded Akron by a 38-34 margin. The 38 rebounds was a season high and it also marked the second straight game the Bearcats have outrebounded their opponent...Junior Dwayne Jackson scored three points in his return home to Akron...After reaching the 80-point plateau in each of its first two games on the 2007-08 season, BU has struggled scoring the ball, failing to score more than 65 points in each of its next three contests...Richard Forbes and Trifunovic both continued their climb among the Bearcats DI scoring list. With eight points Forbes moved into 10th place, surpassing former Bearcat Steve Proctor '07 with 398 career points. Trifunovic also moved passed Proctor and trails Forbes with 394 points and now sits in 11th place on the DI list.

THREE STRAIGHT DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR BEARCATS' SERBIAN BIG MAN

Lazar Trifunovic had back-to-back double-doubles to pace Bearcats this past week. Trifunovic hit 8-of-11 shots for 17 points and grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds in overtime loss to CCSU. He then followed that up with 17 pts. and 13 boards in a road loss to Akron. The 6-foot-8 big man has three double-doubles in five games this season and six for his career.

MOVING ON UP

Mike Gordon begins his race for 1,000 career points in 2007-08. Gordon entered the season needing 352 points to become BU's 18th all-time member of the school's 1,000 point club. Last season, former guard Troy Hailey '07 became the first Bearcat to reach the milestone in the school's DI era. Gordon recently passed Anthony Green to move into fifth place on the school's DI scoring list. Richard Forbes and Lazar Trifunovic both continue to move up to the school's top ten list this season, occupying the 10th and 11th spots, respectively.

ROAD WOES

The Bearcats are looking to improve some woeful numbers in away games. In three road losses this season, BU is allowing 83 points per game and is shooting just 35.8%, compared to opponents' 49% from the field, and a paltry 27.3 percent from behind the arc. Home opponents have converted 43% from three-point range and have outrebounded the Bearcats by an average of 10.3 boards.

FOREIGN FLAVOR

Binghamton University is proud of its reputation as a welcoming campus for international students. Last year, BU hosted 1,523 students from 99 countries, pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees. Nowhere is that diversity more apparent than the men's basketball roster. Binghamton has players from six different countries (Bosnia, Canada, Cameroon, France, Serbia, United States) and a total of seven players that were born outside the United States. No other Division I men's program has as many countries represented on its roster or as many players born outside the U.S.

SOPHOMORE SENSATION

Lazar Trifunovic's 24 points against Quinnipiac earned him yet another spot in the BU record book with the most points scored by a sophomore (in Division I). Trifunovic, who already has the record for most points by a freshman, topped former Bearcat Troy Hailey's 22-point performance against Maine on February 6, 2005.

SHOOTING THE LIGHTS OUT FROM DOWNTOWN

Binghamton enjoyed a record-setting shooting performance in its home-opening win over Quinnipiac. The Bearcats shot 75 percent (9-12) from three-point range setting the highest single game three-point field goal percentage in the school's DI era.

A HIGH SCORING AFFAIR

MAGIC MIKE'S MILESTONES

Senior guard **Mike Gordon** recorded his 300th career assist and 150th career steal against Quinnipiac. Gordon now has career totals of 670 points, 256 rebounds, 301 assists and 150 steals. Gordon is the first player in the Division I era to accomplish this feat and is joined by guard **Jeremy Greenberg** as the only two players in all-time school history to be in the 650-250-300-150 club. Greenberg played for Binghamton from 1990-94.

BROADUS PICKS UP FIRST WIN OVER QUINNPIAC

Lazar Trifunovic scored a game-high 24 points, including

10 straight in a pivotal second-half stretch, and Binghamton held off visiting Quinnipiac 88-75 in Coach Broadus and the Bearcats' home debut on November 14. Trifunovic added 10 rebounds to record the fourth double-double of his career.

BEARCATS FALL IN OPENER AT BONAVENTURE

Binghamton lost its season opener to St. Bonaventure 97-80 on Monday night. Zarryon Fereti scored a game-high 32 points and Michael Lee added 26 points and 11 rebounds. In his Bearcats debut, junior forward **Milos Klimovic** nailed 6-of-12 three-pointers en route to a team-high 23 points. Senior guard **Richard Forbes** netted 15 points and junior forward **Reggie Fuller** added 10 points and seven rebounds. Fereti's 32 points were the highest individual total given up by the Bearcats since Taylor Coppentrath netted 34 for Vermont on March 6, 2005 in the America East Tournament, hosted in Binghamton. BU shot a school-record 34 three pointers.

KLIMOVIC SHOOTS HIS WAY INTO BU RECORD BOOK

Junior transfer **Milos Klimovic** made his way into the Binghamton Div. I record book with his Bearcat debut against St. Bonaventure. His six three-point field goals made ties the single game school record and his 23 total points is the most ever by a Bearcat making in his debut. His six 3-pointers tied the school's Division I record held by Andre Heard, Schafer Jackson, Mike Wright and Jeffrey Daws. His 12 3-point attempts tied the school's D-I record held by Heard and Anthony Green. His 23 points eclipsed the 14 scored by Alex Adediran in his career debut vs. St. Mary's (Calif.) on November 21, 2003.

OPENING NIGHT STRUGGLES

With the loss against the Bonnies it makes four-straight opening game losses for the team. The margin of 17 has been the largest of each of the last four openers. The last time Binghamton won an opener was in the 2002-03 season with a win at home against Lafayette 77-68.

PRESEASON NOTEBOOK

- First-year coach **Kevin Broadus** signed with Binghamton three days after helping lead the Georgetown Hoyas to the NCAA Final Four. Broadus coached at Georgetown for three years and before that, helped build a George Washington program for three years.

- Leading the way for the Bearcats is senior point guard **Mike Gordon**. A Preseason All-America East Team choice, Gordon averaged 11.0 ppg, 4.5 apg, and led the America East Conference in steals (1.6 spg) and assist-to-turnover ratio last year and was named a second-team all-star and to the all-defensive team.

- Gordon is complemented by **Lazar Trifunovic**, who averaged 10.9 ppg and 6.5 rpg last year. One of the conference's most productive newcomers, Trifunovic established school freshman records for scoring, rebounding, field goals, and field goal percentage garnering conference all-rookie honors.

- Senior guard **Richard Forbes** torched ACC member Miami for 27 points in BU's 79-74 upset of the Hurricanes last December 18. Forbes, the team's most explosive offensive player and leading returning scorer, scored 15 or more points nine times. With just one start last season, Forbes (11.3 ppg.) ranked among the nation's top-10 for sixth man scoring, reaching as high as No. 6 in mid-February. In high school in NYC, Forbes led the PSAL in scoring — ahead of NBA player Sebastian Telfair.

- Transfer **Milos Klimovic**, who previously committed to Conference USA-member Houston, scored 23 points in his collegiate debut against St. Bonaventure. The total was the most ever by a newcomer in the Division I era.

- The Bearcats were picked to finish fourth in the America East Conference preseason coaches' poll.

Kevin Broadus, Binghamton University Men's Basketball Coach

Kevin Broadus begins his first season as the head coach of the Binghamton basketball program in 2007-08. Broadus is the 11th head coach in Binghamton's 60 years of basketball and the second since the school made the jump to Division I in 2001. He takes over the Bearcats after spending the last three years as an assistant coach for Georgetown.

At Georgetown, Broadus worked alongside head coach John Thompson III, and the Hoyas' recent national resurgence is a direct result of his recruiting success in the D.C. metro area. Last year's squad went 30-7 and won both the regular season and postseason Big East titles before advancing through the first four rounds of the NCAA tournament to the Final Four. The 2005-06 team went 23-10 and reached the NCAA "Sweet 16" and the 2004-05 team went 19-13 and advanced to the NIT quarterfinals.

Broadus was introduced as Binghamton's new head coach on March 26, 2007, just days before coaching Georgetown in the Final Four. Also, in the same month he was ranked No. 6 by on-line publication *hoopscooponline.com* on their list of the *Top 100 Assistant Coaches in the College Game Today*.

Prior to Georgetown, Broadus was an assistant coach at George Washington for three years. In 2003-04, his Colonials team won 18 games and was selected to the NIT. From 1998 to 2001, he was on the staff at American University and also had coaching stints at University of the District of Columbia (1994-97) and Bowie State University (Md.) (1990-93).

Broadus is known as an excellent recruiter and four of his former recruits are playing in the NBA. Three of his players from his time at George Washington were on NBA rosters in the 2006-07 season. Mike Hall played for the Washington Wizards, Pops Mensah-Bonsu played for the Dallas Mavericks and Danilo 'JR' Pinnock was with the Los Angeles Lakers.

Broadus' most-accomplished recruit is former Georgetown forward Jeff Green. He coached Green over a three-year span in which Green won Big East Co-Rookie of the Year honors, Big East second-team all-conference honors and the Big East Player of the Year award. Green and Broadus' Hoyas had a 30-7 record in 2006-07 and made it to the NCAA Final Four. Green was drafted fifth overall in the 2007 NBA draft by the Boston Celtics and was involved in a draft day trade, shipping him to Seattle.

Broadus earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Bowie State in 1990 and went on to receive his master's degree in counseling from UDC in 1995.

He was a three-year letterwinner at Bowie State, earning conference all-rookie honors in 1984 and leading the team in scoring as team captain in his senior season. He played his first collegiate season at Grambling University in Louisiana. Broadus attended Dunbar High School in Washington, D.C. and Montgomery Blair High School in Silver Spring, Md.

In addition to his college coaching resume, Broadus has worked as a summer camp coach and counselor for both the Philadelphia 76ers and the New York Knicks. He also served four years as a research assistant at the National Institute of Health in Bethesda.

Broadus and his wife, Belinda, have four children: Nicol (23), Milan (14), Paris (13) and Kevin Jr. (11).

SCHEDULE NOTES

• The 2007-08 non-conference schedule features two games against NCAA tournament teams (George Washington, Central Connecticut State) and three teams that won 20 or more games (G.W., CCSU and Akron). Akron went 26-7 and was runnerup in the Mid-American Conference, just missing an NCAA tournament berth. George Washington, where Broadus served as assistant coach from 2001-04, went 23-9 and won the Atlantic-10 title. Central Connecticut State won the Northeast Conference regular season and tournament titles and went 22-12 overall.

• The 2007-08 non-conference schedule is a 12-game slate (plus ESPN Bracketbuster game) with opponents from six different conferences. Binghamton opens and closes their non-conference schedule against St. Bonaventure. The Bearcats will play away against the Bonnies on Nov. 12, and closes their schedule at home against them on Dec. 30. Seven of the 10 non-conference opponents played .500 or better last season and five of those teams finished in the top-three in their league. In addition, three teams won 20 or more games a year ago. The overall conference record of BU's 10 opponents was 88-58 (60%).

• Other teams that fared well in their conferences were Cornell (16-12, third in Ivy), Fordham (18-12, fourth in A-10) and Quinnipiac (third in Northeast). The Dec. 28 game at Fordham will be the first-ever game against the Rams.

• The schedule also includes return matchups with 2006-07 opponents Rider (Dec. 1) and Colgate (Dec. 5) and a home-and-home series with independent Chicago State (Nov. 17 away and Dec. 22 at home).

• For the first time, the Bearcats were selected to participate in the sixth annual O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters series, which will be televised on ESPN2, ESPNU and ESPN Classic on Friday and Saturday, February 22-23. The Bearcats will join fellow America East schools Albany, Boston University and Vermont in the two-day, 50-game event, which typically features prominent teams from mid-major conferences. Binghamton's game will be an away contest, with the Bearcats hosting that same team at the Events Center during the 2008-09 season.
