ON THE MATCHUP...

Binghamton plays the first of four games away from home against one of the few Division I programs younger than itself. The Bearcats are in their sixth Division I season, while the Ospreys are in just their second.



ON THE BEARCATS...

Binghamton snapped a three-game losing streak with an improbable turnaround Friday against LIU. The Bearcats trailed by as many as 17 points in the second half before offering an offensive explosion that produced the second-highest point total in the team's six-year Division I history. A record-setting second half resulted in 62 points —nearly as many as the team's full-game scoring average. Binghamton hit 24-of-26 free throws in the half and junior guard Richard Forbes scored eight consecutive points to break a 77-77 tie and swing the game in BU's favor. Forbes wound up with 19 points, all in the second half. Senior guard Troy Hailey (19 pts.), senior guard Steve Proctor (17) and junior guard Mike Gordon (15) also reached double figures.

ON THE OSPREYS...

North Florida, in its second season of Division I, has dropped five straight games, including a 61-44 setback at William & Mary on December 8. The Ospreys have stayed sharp by playing an exhibition game, however, and defeated crosstown foe Edward Waters 61-52 on Saturday at home. Senior Rashad Williams collected 21 points and 11 rebounds.

ON THE SERIES...

The Bearcats won the first meeting last season, 71-64, at the Events Center.

20 MINUTES TO REMEMBER

Binghamton's 62 second-half points against LIU surpasses the 54 scored in the final period against Boston University on February 9, 2003 for the highest single half scoring output in program history. The Bearcats scored 58 of the 62 points over the final 13:58. The 91 points is second only to the 94 points BU score against Northeastern on January 12, 2002. It is also a new record for most points in a home game. Headed into the contest, BU was averaging 63.7 points per contest.

PROCTOR'S CAREER NIGHT PROPELS 'CATS

Despite shooting just 3-of-10 from the field in Friday's win, senior guard **Steve Proctor** played one of his finest overall games since coming to Binghamton. He enjoyed a career evening with 17 points, six assists and four steals and 10 of 11 from the charity stripe — including a perfect 9-for-9 in the second half.

FORBES STRIKES IT RICH IN FINAL PERIOD

After scoring two points in just over a 25 minute of action spanning three contests, including a scoreless first half against LIU, **Richard Forbes** exploded for 19 points to spearhead BU's come-from-behind victory. The scoring outburst included a stretch where he scored eight consecutive points to break a 77-77 deadlock and give BU the lead for good.

IT AIN'T OVER TIL IT'S OVER

The Bearcats seemed destined for a fourth straight defeat against LIU as they trailed 50-33 with 14 minutes to go and were down 72-63 with 6:52 left. BU ran off a 58-30 run to mount its largest comeback of the season. The win marks the first time this season the Bearcats have come out on top when trailing at halftime.

MILESTONE VICTORY FOR WALKER

Friday's win over Long Island was the 225th in Coach Al Walker's career. Walker is 225-267 (.456) in his 18th season as a collegiate head coach.

Binghamton set a season-high in steals, registering 13 thefts compared to zero for LIU. This represents BU's largest single-game advantage in steals. The previous best came when the Bearcats outswiped New Hampshire 15-5 on February 14, 2004.

LIU POSTGAME NOTES, NEWS, TRENDS...

- BU enjoyed its most successful night of the season from the floor, shooting 47%
- A season-best four Bearcats reached double digits in scoring.
- The win equaled a DI program record for non-league wins (4)
- BU connected on all but two of its 26 second-half free throw attempts (92%). The 24 free throws is the most BU has ever hit in a single half.
- It was the second time this season that BU has connected on atleast 10 three pointers in a game.
- BU's starting five outscored its second unit for the first time this season.
- Eighty-four percent (76-of-91) of BU's points came from its guards.

2006-07 BOX SCORES AND GAME RECAPS

GAME 1 - LONG ISLAND 73, BINGHAMTON 59

BROOKLYN, N.Y. - Long Island University (1-0) built a 10-point halftime lead and held visiting Binghamton (0-1) to 34% shooting in a 73-59 victory in the season opener for both teams from the Wellness Center.

The Blackbirds opened the game with a 10-0 run and maintained a double-digit lead for much of the contest as the Bearcats struggled to find any offensive rhythm. Binghamton did use an 8-2 run to pull within four, 48-44, with 10:31 remaining, but LIU immediately responded with a 9-0 run to regain its margin.

Long Island put four players in double figures, led by senior guard James Williams, who scored a game-high 17 points.

Senior guard Troy Hailey and junior guard Mike Gordon led the Bearcats with 11 points apiece. Junior guard Richard Forbes scored nine points - all in the second half - and added four steals in 22 minutes. Freshman forward Lazar Trifunovic pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds in 23 minutes of action before fouling out late in the contest.

The Bearcats struggled offensively out of the gate, missing 10 of the team's first 12 shots and digging the early 10-point deficit. A modest 6-0 run cut the margin to six with 4:53 left before the Blackbirds stretched their lead back to 10, 35-25 at the break. To compound its offensive woes, BU racked up 15 turnovers in the first half and hit just 2-of-10 three-point attempts (4-of-24 for game).

"I'm disappointed that we played so poorly in the first half and didn't give ourselves a chance," head coach Al Walker said. "We played hard but you're not going to beat people turning the ball over 15 times in the first half. We did have a couple of good spurts in the second half. We're going to get better."

GAME 2 - BINGHAMTON 74, Niagara 66

NIAGARA UNIV., N.Y. - Junior guard Richard Forbes netted a career-high 24 points, including four-of-six from three-point range, to lead visiting Binghamton (1-1) to a 74-66 victory over Niagara (0-1) in a men's college basketball game Thursday night from the Gallagher Center.

Forbes, who paced four Bearcats to score in double figures, delivered a terrific all-around effort, finishing with nine rebounds, a team-high three assists and an 8-of-9 mark from the charity stripe.

Leading 55-53 with just over seven minutes to play in the second half, BU used a 15-4 run to pull away from the host Purple Eagles en route to its first victory of the 2006-07 season.

The exclamation point of the spurt came as Forbes fed senior forward Duane James, who exploded through the lane for an emphatic slam dunk to make it 68-57 and thwart any Niagara hopes for a late rally. James finished the evening with 10 points and 10 rebounds for his second career double-double.

"Tonight was just a great overall effort for our team," head coach Al Walker said. "The last two years we've struggled out of the gate. So this is a very significant win for us."

Junior guard Mike Gordon added 15 points and four treys of his own before fouling out late in the contest for Binghamton, while senior guard Troy Hailey chipped in with 12 points and seven rebounds in 26 minutes of action.

BU struggled at the onset for the second consecutive contest, hitting on only three of its first 19 field goal attempts, falling into a 14-5 hole midway through the first half. This time around, however, the Bearcats would regain their shooting touch, nailing 10 of their next 17 as part of a 25-11 surge that saw them close out the half with a 34-31 advantage.

Spearheading the surge was the stellar outside shooting of both Forbes and Gordon, as the pair of junior guards combined to hit on 6-of-12 (50%) three point field goals in the contest's first frame. BU finished the game shooting 40 percent (8-of-20) from beyond the arc, while the host Purple Eagles were 5-of-34 (14.8%).

Niagara put three players in double figures, led by senior forward Cliff Brown, who racked up a double-double with 19 points and a game-high 21 rebounds. Senior forward J.R. Duffey added 14 points and seven rebounds in the losing effort.

NOTES: The win gave Al Walker his 80th victory at BU...Brown's 21 rebounds were the most by a Binghamton opponent since the program moved to the Division I level.

VESTAL, N.Y. - Binghamton senior guard Steve Proctor sank three free throws in the final 20 seconds to preserve a 66-59 victory over visiting Mt. Binghamton held Mt. St. Mary's without a field goal for the game's first 4:26 and built a 14-2 cushion with five different players scoring in the run. The lead swelled to as many as 17 points before BU settled for a 33-22 halftime lead.

In addition to Proctor, three other Bearcats reached double figures. Junior guard Richard Forbes scored 14 points on 4-for-6 shooting, senior guard Troy Hailey hit 3-of-3 from three-point range en route to 11 points and junior guard Mike Gordon added 10 points and six assists.

Mt. St. Mary's was led by freshman guard Jeremy Goode, who scored a game-high 18 points.

VESTAL, N.Y.-- Freshman forward Lazar Trifunovic sank two free throws with 27 seconds left and Binghamton (3-1) withstood two inside shots in the frantic waning seconds to preserve a 57-56 victory over visiting Cornell (3-2) in a men's college basketball game Saturday afternoon at the Events Center. The win stretches BU's win streak to three.

Trifunovic, who scored of 10 of his 12 points in the pivotal second half, grabbed a big offensive rebound off a BU miss with 27 seconds left, and drew the foul with BU down 56-55. He calmly sank both free throws to create the final margin.

"I thought our guys played our hearts out today," head coach Al Walker said. "It was a great win for us ... Cornell is playing very well. It was a hard-fought game and for the third straight game, we shot the ball well."

The second half was a see-saw affair, with neither team leading by more than three points.

Senior guard Troy Hailey, BU's leading scorer with 15 points, scored six points in the final 2:27 - on a three-pointer with 2:27 left and a three-point play with 1:33 to play. Hailey hit 5-of-6 from the field and in the process, extended his consecutive three-point streak. He hit all four of his three-attempts and has connected on seven straight shots from beyond the arc.

Binghamton led 33-30 at intermission but missed nine of the team's first 10 shots to begin the sluggish second half. The teams combined for just two field goals in the first 7:48 of the period. From that point on, however, the Bearcats shot 7-of-12 to finish the game.

Trifunovic hit 3-of-4 from the floor, including several difficult turnaround jumpers.

"Lazar played a great game," Walker said. "He carried us down the stretch."

Junior guard Richard Forbes scored 13 points, with 10 of those coming in the first half.

Cornell forward Ryan Wittman led all scorers with 19 points.

NOTES: Troy Hailey was selected as the America East Player of the Game ... this is Binghamton's best start of the season since the 2002-03 season (3-0) ... this was the first meeting between the two Central New York schools in 16 years.

GAME 5 - COLGATE 78, BINGHAMTON 70

HAMILTON, N.Y. -- Colgate senior guard Jon Simon scored a game-high 23 points to lead Colgate (2-2) to a 78-70 win over visiting Binghamton (3-2) in a men's college basketball game Monday night from Cotterell Court. The loss snapped BU's three-game win streak.

Simon torched BU's defense for 17 second-half points, including nine straight to erase a four-point Colgate deficit midway through the second half. The Bearcats led 41-37 four minutes into the second half when Simon took control of the game. He netted a three-pointer, converted a four-point play and made a layup - all within a span of 1:27 - as Colgate forged ahead for good. Simon wound up hitting 12 points during a 19-6 run that resulted in a 56-47 lead with less than 10 minutes to play. Colgate kept BU at bay the rest of the way before settling on the final eight-point margin.

Junior guard Richard Forbes scored a team-high 19 points and pulled down six rebounds. Senior forward Duane James (Miami, Fla.) collected 18 points, tying his career-best total, and six boards and junior guard Mike Gordon added 13 points, respectively. Freshman forward Lazar Trifunovic chipped in eight points and seven rebounds in 16 minutes of action.

Colgate shot 54% and earned numerous second-chance points with strong rebounding against a BU team that was playing its second game in a three-day span. The Raiders shot 54% from the field and added seven blocks to their defensive effort.

"Colgate was better than us tonight," head coach Al Walker said. "They dominated the game. We didn't defend at a high level and we need to learn from this and get better."

The Bearcats struggled out of the gate, missing 13 of the team's first 15 shots and digging an early eight-point deficit before James led a late charge. The 6-foot-6 senior forward stepped out to can a pair of three-pointers in the final six minutes - including one that rolled softly around the rim before falling in at the halftime buzzer to knot the score at 31-31. James scored all 10 of his first-half points in the final 5:47 of the stanza.

NOTES: The 78 points allowed were the most Binghamton has given up since allowing 78 in a loss to UMBC last February 2 - a span of 14 games...With two assists, Mike Gordon surpasses Anthony Green '03 to become BU's D-I all-time leader in assists (186)...The Bearcats are now an even 3-3 all-time against Patriot League opponents...James' 18 points equals his career best set last year at Mount St. Mary's (11-21-05).

VESTAL, N.Y. -- Rider junior forward Jason Thompson posted game-highs of 23 points and 12 rebounds and sophomore guard Lamar Johnson netted 13 points in a 2:52 span late in the game to lead the Broncs (5-2) to a 79-65 win over host Binghamton (3-3) in a men's college basketball game Saturday afternoon from the Events Center. The loss denies the Bearcats their first 3-0 start at home at the Division I level.

With the score knotted at 60-60 with 4:36 left, Johnson scored seven points during a 9-0 Rider run that gave them the lead for good. During the stretch, BU turned the ball over on three consecutive possessions.

After lighting up the scoreboard in the first half to the tune of a season-high 42 points, BU went cold in the second, managing just nine field goals (26%). In contrast, the Broncs shot 52% and then sealed the victory with 11-of-12 marksmanship from the free throw line.

"I thought we defended fairly well and got out in transition," head coach Al Walker said of his team's first half play. "But we couldn't get the job done defensively in the second half."

Senior forward Duane James led BU with 16 points, but played only 14 minutes after absorbing a blow to the head early in the second half. James returned in the closing minutes but the outcome had been decided. He hit 5-of-7 from the floor and grabbed five rebounds.

Freshman forward Lazar Trifunovic and junior guard Mike Gordon scored 10 points apiece. Trifunovic pulled down seven rebounds in his longest stint of the season (33 minutes). Gordon scored all of his points in the first half. Sophomore guard Dwayne Jackson earned his first collegiate start and added nine points, four rebounds and three steals in 25 minutes of work.

Binghamton continues its three-game homestand when they host Akron on December 6 for a 7 p.m. contest.

GAME 5 - AKRON 90, BINGHAMTON 55

VESTAL, N.Y. -- Akron (5-1) opened the game with a 19-4 run and never looked back in posting a 90-55 win over host Binghamton (3-4) in a men's college basketball game Wednesday evening from the Events Center. The Zips stretched their win streak to five and in the process, pinned the worst home defeat on the Bearcats in the program's six years of Division I play.

Akron scored the game's first 10 points, shot 58% in the first half and carried a 15-point bulge into halftime, 47-32. They opened the second half with a 13-2 run to wipe out any BU comeback hopes. Junior forward Jeremiah Wood led three Akron players in double figures with 14 points and 12 rebounds. He hit all six of his shots from the field and grabbed six offensive rebounds. Junior guard Nick Dials added 14 points - thanks to 4-for-8 shooting from three-point range.

Akron outrebounded Binghamton 46-26 and wound up shooting 52% from the floor, including 10-for-23 accuracy from beyond the arc (44%).

Freshman forward Lazar Trifunovic led BU with 13 points and seven rebounds. Trifunovic hit 4-of-5 from the field and 5-of-6 from the free throw line. Senior guard Steve Proctor added 10 points.

Binghamton wraps up its three-game homestand when it hosts Long Island University at 7 p.m. on December 15.

NOTES: Lazar Trifunovic was named the America East Player of the Game ... The 90 points represents the most points BU has allowed at home since Division III Hamilton scored 106 points in a triple overtime win at West Gym in 1994 ... The 35-point margin of defeat was the largest since Vermont posted a 71-44 win over BU on January 27, 2005.

GAME 5 - BINGHAMTON 91, LONG ISLAND 80

VESTAL, N.Y. -- Junior guard Richard Forbes led an offensive explosion in the second half as Binghamton (4-4) rallied past visiting Long Island University (4-7) 91-80 Friday night from the Events Center. Forbes scored all 19 of his points in the pivotal second half as BU put a program-best 61 points on the board to erase a 12-point halftime deficit. The 91 points are the second most in Binghamton's six years of Division I play.

The Bearcats seemed destined for a fourth straight defeat as they trailed by 16 midway through the second half and were down 72-63 with 6:52 left. But BU embarked on a 14-5 run to tie the score at 77-77 with 3:42 remaining and Forbes took over. He scored eight consecutive points beginning with a three-pointer with 2:18 left which gave BU the lead for good. Forbes followed with yet another three with 1:31 left and a driving layup in traffic to stretch Binghamton's lead to 85-77 with 50 seconds left. The Bearcats then sank six free throws in the final 38 seconds to seal the win.

"We certainly played harder in the second half," head coach Al Walker said. "I'm so proud of the guys. We showed a lot of character. This was a game where down the stretch, we had the energy, passion and commitment to make plays."

In the second half, BU hit 24-of-26 free throws (92%) as both teams traded trips to the free throw line. For the game, 59 fouls were called and five players fouled out of the game.

Senior guard Troy Hailey scored 12 of his season-high 19 points in the second half and senior guard Steve Proctor added 13 of his season-high 17 points in the final frame. Proctor sank 10-of-11 free throws to boost his total, and he added six assists and four steals. Junior guard Mike Gordon was BU's fourth player in double figures with 15 points. Gordon also produced four assists and three steals.

Senior guard James Williams scored a game-high 22 points to lead the Blackbirds.

NOTES: Forbes was named the America East Player of the Game ... Binghamton's offensive output is second only to the 94 points BU scored against Northeastern on January 12, 2002 ... The 61 second-half points surpasses the 54 scored in the final period against Boston University on February 9, 2003.
